WHAT:

Auditory and Language Processing Disorders

This mini course is about the special educator's role with understanding auditory and language processing disorders through assessment and intervention. **7.0 hours of professional learning credit.**

Social Communication and Engagement Triad (SCET)

The SCET Triad is a 6-week, self-paced course with six modules to learn about the interconnectedness between communication and engagement. The course is intended for educators who support students with autism spectrum disorder or other complex communication disorders. **7.5 hours of professional learning credit.**

Strategies to Write Informational Text

This training is designed for educators who support students with disabilities who struggle with writing. It review fundamental skills students must master to become effective writers of informational text. 15 hours of professional learning credit.

SLPA Supervision in Schools

This course is designed for any speech-language pathologist who is new to supervising/mentoring an SLPA in Colorado or who needs a review. It includes collaborative models of supervision, roles and responsibilities of supervisors and the roles and responsibilities of SLPAs according to Colorado standards. **The course meets the ASHA's two hour supervision requirement and ten CDE contact hours are available.**
