When a child with a disability enrolls in and attends a public charter school, the district of residence is responsible for paying the charter school or the chartering authority the daily special education cost rate for the additional cost incurred in educating the child pursuant to the Exceptional Children's Educational Act (ECEA) and State Board Rule [ECEA, 1 CCR 301-8, 2220-R-9.03(2)(b)]. The costs rates are calculated by CDE annually according to ECEA Rule [ECEA, 1 CCR 301-8, 2220-R-9.06(2)].
