How To Use ISIP[™] Oral Reading Fluency At Home

Schools may be closed due to COVID-19, but educators can still make sure students are on track to master oral reading skills with Istation's Indicators of Progress (ISIP[™])

Oral Reading Fluency (ORF) assessment.

With ISIP Oral Reading Fluency, students have the opportunity to demonstrate their reading accuracy through the oral reading of text. Teachers have access to an online archive of student recordings. Also, students can now record passages from home giving teachers the insight to determine whether students are on track to meet reading goals during this time of distance learning.

Helpful Hints from Support Services

How to change the domain on the login screen (all users):

- 1. Open the app.
- 2. Click the **Change School** button in the bottom right corner of the screen.
- 3. Type the school domain using the following format: school name. the district. the state.

Password reset:

- 1. Go to the <u>Forgotten Your Username or Password</u> page
- 2. Input your district e-mail address. If you're in the system, you will receive an email with your username and a link to change your password.

This will work for those who have forgotten their password as well as those who are new to Istation and have not yet set up their account.

How to access the training videos:

- 1. Go to the <u>Help Center</u> and log in.
- 2. Click View Training Videos on the right side of the page.

How to access the Interactive User Guide (IUG):

- 1. Go to the <u>Help Center</u> and log in.
- 2. Click on the green box that saysGo to FAQs.

How to check if a student is still logged in to the program:

- 1. Go to the student's profile on the Istation website by searching for their name or selecting their name from your Classroom page.
- 2. On the student's profile, locate **Last Program Login**, which displays a status indicating how long the student has been logged in during the current session.
 - If there is no status listed, they are not currently logged in to the program.

How to install the Istation app:

- 1. Go to the <u>Istation School Closures</u> page.
- 2. Find step-by-step instructions on how to get the most out of Istation at home.
