Family and School Partnerships in Education Month – November

Whereas, from November 1, 2022, through November 30, 2022, the state of Colorado celebrates Family and School Partnerships in Education as a time to recognize the importance of family engagement in education, learn about Colorado’s family-school partnering resources and celebrate best engagement practices; and

Whereas, studies show that when parents, families, and schools collaborate effectively, students achieve higher levels of academic performance, demonstrate better attendance and homework completion, and are less likely to drop out of school; and

Whereas, students from all backgrounds tend to perform better academically when their parents, families, and the professionals at their schools bridge the gap between the culture at home and the classroom; and

Whereas, students benefit from active involvement by well-informed and engaged parents and families in their life and education; and

Whereas, District 11 aligned efforts with the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) and joined a FSCP— Family, School, Community Partnerships, collaborative cohort with six other Colorado school districts. Participation in this collaborative elevated FSCP as a foundational school improvement strategy; and
