- Colorado Spanish Language Arts (CSLA)
- CoAlt Science



Sequence Number:

A unique seven character alphanumeric code assigned to each record, generated by Data Pipeline. This number cannot be changed.

Responsible District Code:

The district code where the student is enrolled. This district will receive student reports and will also be used as the district for accountability calculations and public reporting of assessment results. Use the four-character code assigned to the district by CDE. NOTE:

If the student did not take the assessment in your district and the student score needs to be transferred to another school in another district (this situation is rare), follow the steps below:

- 1. Contact the receiving district and get approval to transfer the student's scores there. Submit a Failsafe form TO CDE using Syncplicity to request that CDE transfer the score to the new district.
- 2. Send an email to SBD support at CDE (sbdsupport@cde.state.co.us) indicating that there is a file in the Syncplicity folder. If you do not let SBD Support know about the file in Syncplicity, the file will be overlooked and the transfer will NOT take place. Responsible School Code:

The school code where the student is enrolled. This school will be used for accountability calculations and public reporting. Use the four-character code assigned to the school by CDE. You may change the school code during the SBD Review Process as long as the new school is in the same district.

NOTE: If the student did not take the assessment in your district and the student score needs to be transferred to another school in another district (this situation is rare), follow the steps shown above under "Responsible District Code."

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Responsible District Name:

Official CDE District name based on Responsible District Code.

Responsible School Name:

Official CDE School name based on Responsible School Code.

Testing District Code:

The district code where the assessment was administered. Use the four-character code assigned to the district by CDE.

Testing School Code:

The school code where the assessment was administered. Use the four-character code assigned to the school by CDE.

Testing District Name:

Official CDE District name where the assessment was administered based on Testing District Code.

Testing School Name:

Official CDE School name where the assessment was administered based on Testing School Code.

SASID:

A unique ten-digit number assigned to each student by CDE.

LASID:

A unique number assigned to each student locally. You may leave this field blank.

Student Last Name:

Student's last name as recorded in RITS.

Student First Name:

Student's first name as recorded in RITS.

Preferred Student First Name:

The first name used by a student other than their legal first name that they would prefer to appear on materials presented to the student including student and parent facing reports (for any reason). This field is not required and can be left blank.

Student Middle Name:

Student's middle name. This field is not compared to data in RITS. You may leave this field blank.

Student Date of Birth:

Student's date of birth as recorded in RITS. Format = MMDDYYYY.

Student Gender:

Student's sex as recorded in RITS. 01 = Female; 02 = Male; 03 = Nonbinary

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Grade Level:

Student's grade level at test administration. This field determines which assessments the student received during the testing window. If the student was promoted to 12th grade before testing but was registered for 11th grade science, add the Not Tested Reason of '03' to resolve the error. For any other cases where the student record has a grade that is incorrect, please contact SBD Support for further instructions.

Valid Values:

- 030 = Grade 3
- 040 = Grade 4
- 050 = Grade 5
- 060 = Grade 6
- 070 = Grade 7
- 080 = Grade 8
- 110 = Grade 11

Race/Ethnicity Fields:

For information regarding the ethnicity and race reporting categories, see the CDE Race and Ethnicity Brochure at http://www.cde.state.co.us/cdereval/rvRace-Ethnicity.htm

For each of the fields below, use 1 to indicate that the definition describes the race/ethnicity of the student or 0 to indicate that the definition does not describe the student's race/ethnicity.

IMPORTANT: A student can be included in more than one race group.

- Student's Ethnicity: Hispanic or Latino A person having origins in Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture, regardless of race. The term 'Spanish origin' can be used in addition to 'Hispanic/Latino or Latino.
- Student's Race: American Indian or Alaska Native A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North or South America (including Central America) and who maintains a tribal affiliation or community recognition

NOTE: The summary value for the race and ethnicity fields will be calculated based on the data in the ethnicity and individual student race fields described above. To review the final updated values, a calculated field will be included in the Final Summary report in COGNOS. To update the value for this calculated field, make appropriate changes to the six ethnicity and individual student race fields noted above.

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Free/Reduced Lunch Eligible:

Students meets the eligibility criteria for free or reduced lunch pursuant to the provisions of the Federal National School Lunch Act. Valid Values: (Interchange or vendor values may be used)

- 00 or N = Not eligible
- 01 or Y = Free lunch eligible
- 02 or Y = Reduced lunch eligible

For specific guidelines in meeting the criteria for free/reduced lunch, refer to the procedures manual and the Rules for the Administration of the Public School Finance Act.

NOTE: Although a school may not provide a lunch program, students who are eligible for Free/Reduced lunch must be coded as such. Districts may use October count data or updated information if it is available.

IEP or 504 Plan:

Student has an individualized education program (IEP) and/or is identified as handicapped under regulations implementing Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 but may or may not be eligible for special education placement under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. This field should be based on the student's status at the time of testing. If Accommodation Type Used = IEP504 or Both, changing this field to blank will cause an error. Contact SBD Support for assistance with the error if the student should not have had an accommodation.

Valid Values:

- IEP = Student has IEP
- 504 = Student has 504 Plan
- BLANK = Student does not have an IEP or 504 Plan

If a student has both an IEP and 504 plan, use 'IEP.'

Accommodation Type Used:

This field indicates whether a student used accommodations on the assessment that require the student to have an IEP/504 Plan or have a Language Proficiency of 1 = NEP or 2 = LEP. If this field indicates that an accommodation was used, changes to IEP/504 or Language Proficiency will cause an error. If your district data indicates that the student did not have an IEP or was not a multilingual learner at the time of testing, please contact SBD Support.

Valid Values:

- IEP504 = Student used one or more accommodations that require an IEP/504 Plan
- ML = Student used one or more accommodations based on the student's Multilingual learner (ML) status.
- Either = Student used one or more accommodations that require either an IEP/504 Plan or ML status
- Both = Student used accommodations that require both an IEP/504 Plan and ML status.

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Language Background:

A three-character code that identifies the native language of multilingual learners. Following is a list of some of the most commonly used Language Background codes. For a complete list of Language Background codes go to

Primary Disability:

Student's primary disability. If the student has more than one disability, report the major disability as reflected on the student's IEP. Valid Values:

- 00 = None
- 01 = Intellectual disability
- 03 = Emotional disability
- 04 = Specific learning disability
- 05 = Hearing impairment
- 06 = Visual impairment
- 08 = Speech or language impairment
- 09 = Deaf-blindness
- 10 = Multiple disabilities
- 11 = Developmental delay
- 13 = Autism spectrum disorders
- 14 = Traumatic brain injury
- 15 = Orthopedic impairment
- 16 = Other health impairment

All students with a Primary Disability must also have an IEP.

Homeless:

Flag if the student meets the criteria of a homeless individual according to the 2001 McKinney-Vento reauthorization Act Subtitle VII-B of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act reauthorized in 2015 by the Title IX, Part A of the Every Student Succeeds Act. Valid Values:

- 0 = No
- 3 = Yes and in custody of parent/guardian
- 4 = Yes and not in custody of parent/guardian

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Language Proficiency:

A rating that describes a student's ability to speak, to listen, to read, and to write in English. This field should be based on the student's status at the time of testing. If Accommodation Type Used = ML or Both, this field must be 1 - NEP or 2 - LEP. Any other value will cause an error. Contact SBD Support for assistance if the student should not have had an accommodation.

Rules regarding FEP (6, 7, 8, and 9) and FELL (5):

Once a student has been FEP for four consecutive school years (two years monitored followed by two years exited) the student should be moved to FELL status.

NOTES:

- Students with a Language Background that is English should be coded as 00 (Not Applicable).
- Students who have a Language Proficiency code of PHLOTE (4) or FELL (5) should be coded as 00 (Not Applicable).
- Students with a Language Background that is not English and have a Language Proficiency code of NEP (1), LEP (2), or FEP Monitored Year 1 (6) or FEP Monitored Year 2 (7) must have a valid code other than 00.
- Students who have a Language Proficiency code of FEP Exited Year 1 (8) or FEP Exited Year 2 (9) may be coded using any Language Instruction Program value.
- Students may not be coded in more than one Language Instruction Program. If multiple programs are used to educate a student, use the one that is predominately used to educate the student.

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Continuous in District:

Use this field to indicate that a student has been continuously enrolled in the district over the course of the academic year leading up to the administration of annual state assessments.

0 = No: 1 = Yes

A student is considered to be continuously enrolled in a district if all of the statements listed below are true. Students failing to meet one or more of these criteria are considered to be non-continuous:

- 1. The student had an active enrollment record in the district on the October count date.
- 2. The student had an active enrollment record in the district at the start of the testing window or at any point prior to the end of the testing window.
- 3. The district code in the student's enrollment record as of the October count date was equal to the district code in the student's enrollment record at the time of the test administration.
- 4. Between the student's enrollment on the October count date and the testing date, there has been no single enrollment gap within the district lasting 10 or more consecutive instructional days.
- 5. Between the student's enrollment on the October count date and the testing date, there have not been multiple non-consecutive enrollment breaks within the district cumulatively equaling 10 or more instructional days.

NOTE: The value that you provide for this field will be compared to the CDE calculated value and will trigger an error if the value you provide does not match the interchange records. If you believe there is an error with the calculated value, contact SBD Support.

Continuous in School:

Use this field to indicate that a student has been continuously enrolled in the school over the course of the academic year leading up to the administration of annual state assessments. The criteria are the same as the criteria used for the Continuous in District field. 0 = No; 1 = Yes

NOTE: The value that you provide for this field will be compared to the CDE calculated value and will trigger an error or warning if the value you provide does not match the interchange records. If you believe there is an error with the calculated value, contact SBD Support.

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Date First Enrolled in US: Date a student first enrolled in any public or non-public US school (not Puerto Rico) in grade kindergarten or higher. Date must be entered in MMDDYYYY format.

- Schools on US military bases count as US schools even if the base is in a different country.
- Home school does not count as a public or non-public school.
- Date First Enrolled in US is based on the earliest entry date in grades kindergarten and higher. The date that a student is enrolled in a preschool program does not count as the Date First Enrolled in US.
- If you enter a date that is later than the date of first enrollment according to CDE's enrollment records, you will receive an error message. In this case, we recommend that you fill this field with 8 zeros and CDE will provide the earlier date.
- If you do not know the date of first enrollment, you may fill this field with 8 zeros. If information is available, CDE will provide the date of first enrollment.
- If you fill this field with 8 zeros and CDE has no prior enrollment information, you will receive an error message. In this case, use the table below to determine the date to use for date of first enrollment. You may need to work with the District Data Respondent or a school registrar to find the entry type code for a student.

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Expelled

Use this field to indicate that a student was expelled at the time of testing. 0 = No; 1 = Yes

NOTES:

The scores of expelled students will not be included in school level reporting, but will be included for all district level and state level reporting. Do not invalidate a student score just because the student was expelled on test day. As long as the student completed the assessment, the score will be included for all district level and state level reporting. For more information, contact SBD support.

Gifted and Talented:

This field indicates a student who has been formally identified, using district-wide procedures aligned with CDE guidelines, as being endowed with a high degree of exceptionality or potential in mental ability, academics, creativity, or a talent (e.g., visualization, performance, musical arts, or leadership).

0 = No; 1 = Yes

Test Code:

This field indicates the assessment that was administered to the student. This field may not be changed during the SBD review process and must be aligned with the student's grade.

Test Content:

Indicates the content area of the assessment

Valid Values:

- MATH Math
- ELA English Language Arts
- CSLA Spanish Language Arts
- SCI Science
- SCIA CoAlt Science
- SS Social Studies
- SSA CoAlt Social Studies

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Test Status:

This field is set by the Pearson scoring team to indicate whether a student has started or completed the assessment. Valid Values:

- Assign Test was assigned to a student but NOT started or completed.
- Attempt Test was assigned to a student and started or completed. Attempt status does not mean that the student will receive a score.

Attemptedness:

This field is set by the Pearson scoring team to indicate that the student responded to enough items on the assessment to receive a score.

- Y Met attemptedness criteria
- N Did not meet attemptedness criteria (these records will not receive a score)

Not Tested Reason:

Not Tested Reasons should be applied to students whose records are in assigned status who did not attempt to test or who were marked Complete in the Pearson system.

NOTE: If the Calculated Invalidation Code is not reflecting the Not Tested Reason, check that the student is in Assign Status.

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Report Suppression Code:

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Calculated Invalidation Code:

This field can also be used to calculate an initial estimate of participation based on your submitted SBD values (final values may change or be subject to review in specific cases).
