CO SAT Record ID Number: A unique code assigned to a record by Data Pipeline used to identify records in this SBD file
There are three sets of district and school codes to help identify the correct responsible district. Responsible District and School are updateable, DO NOT send a Failsafe file to move students from one district to another.

Pre-ID District Code: A unique code assigned to a district by CDE. This is the district of the student's primary enrollment during October Count. If this is blank, then the record was not part of the Pre-ID upload.

Pre-ID District Name: Auto-filled by Data Pipeline.
Pre-ID School Code: A unique code assigned to a school by CDE. This is the district of the student's primary enrollment during October Count. If this is blank, then the record was not part of the Pre-ID upload.

Pre-ID School Name: Auto-filled by Data Pipeline.
Testing District Code: A unique code assigned to a district by CDE. This is the district where the student was tested based on the Supervisor Report Form. If this is blank, no answer sheet was received for the student.

Testing District Name: Auto-filled by Data Pipeline.
Testing School Code: A unique code assigned to a district by CDE. This is the school where the student was tested based on the Supervisor Report Form. If this is blank, no answer sheet was received for the student.

Testing School Name: Auto-filled by Data Pipeline.
Responsible District Code: Updateable. This is the district where the student was enrolled during testing and where they will be counted for accountability. This field will be populated with your district so that the Continuous in District field will automatically calculate. If you are not responsible for the student, then you may update this field to the correct district. During the SBD collection, a warning will highlight records where the Pre-ID and Testing District and School Codes do not match. Make sure to update the Responsible District and School Codes if the students SHOULD NOT be in that district or school for accountability.
Students with mismatched Pre-ID and Testing District and School will appear in the SBD for both districts and each district may indicate what they believe to be the correct responsible District and School. If both districts assign the same Responsible District, the record will be placed in

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that District and no further action is needed. If there is disagreement, CDE will contact both districts after SBD to determine who should be responsible. DO NOT send a Failsafe to move a student to another district.

Responsible District Name: Auto-filled by Data Pipeline.
Responsible School Code: Updateable. This field follows the same rules as the Responsible District. If a student needs to be moved to another school in your district then this field can be updated with no further validation.

Responsible School Name: Auto-filled by Data Pipeline.
Test - Indicates whether the student completed the SAT, PSAT10, or PSAT9 assessment. This is not updateable.
Student Last Name: Student's last name as recorded in RITS.
Student First Name: Student's first name as recorded in RITS.
Preferred Student First Name: This is a new field beginning in the 2023-2024 collection. The first name used by a student other than their legal first name that they would prefer to appear on materials presented to the student including student and parent facing reports (for any reason).
This field is not required and can be left blank.
Middle Initial: Student's middle initial. Blanks are allowed.
Grade Level: Students must be in $9^{\text {th }}$ grade to take CO PSAT $9,10^{\text {th }}$ grade to take the CO PSAT 10 , and $11^{\text {th }}$ grade to take the CO SAT. If a student is not in the appropriate grade for the assessment they took, you will need to contact SBD Support to ignore your errors and determine the most appropriate invalidation code before you can submit. If the student is in $12^{\text {th }}$ grade, you should invalidate the record using code '03' (Withdrew Before or During Testing).

Student Gender: Student's sex as recorded in RITS. 01 = Female; 02 = Male; $03=$ Nonbinary

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## Race/Ethnicity Fields:

SASID: A unique number assigned to each student by CDE. The Missing SASID Report in COGNOS shows possible matching SASIDs for any records with a missing SASID. Please verify that the SASID is actually for the correct student before using any suggested SASIDs. If the missing SASID is not in the report, it may be necessary to contact the school to resolve. If you cannot identify the student, contact SBD Support.

Last Update: March 14, 2024

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The following fields are not collected by College Board. They will be added to the SBD file from the Student Interchange Data Pipeline collection for inclusion in the final CO PSAT/CO SAT data file to meet federal and state reporting requirements. If these data are not correct or available in Data Pipeline, they may be updated during the SBD review.

Free and Reduced Lunch Eligibility: Student meets the eligibility criteria for free or reduced lunch pursuant to the provisions of the Federal National School Lunch Act. For specific guidelines in meeting the criteria for free/reduced lunch, refer to the procedures manual and the Rules for the Administration of the Public School Finance Act.

NOTE: Although a school may not provide a lunch program, eligibility should be marked if documented. Districts may use October count data or updated information if it is available.

Gifted and Talented: Student who has been formally identified, using district-wide procedures aligned with CDE guidelines, as being endowed with a high degree of exceptionality or potential in mental ability, academics, creativity, or a talent (e.g., visualization, performance, musical arts, or leadership). Students are provided instructional accommodations in the classroom and other school or district options on a continuum of services according to identified strengths. The instructional program provides special educational opportunities including acceleration, differentiated instruction, affective and career counseling, and high-level enrichment. A plan for services might include options and resources outside the classroom such as parent, community, or higher-education interventions and resources.

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Language Proficiency: Student's English language proficiency is described by his or her ability to speak, to listen, to read, and to write in English. Multilingual learners must have an English proficiency rating entered (1 or 2), and non-multilingual students must be coded as 0 or 4. Former multilingual learner students $s$ should be coded as 5.

- 2 = LEP - Limited English Proficient
- $4=$ PHLOTE - Primary or Home Language Other Than English
- 5 = FELL - Former ELL

- $8=\mathrm{FEP}$, Exited Year 1
- 9= FEP, Exited Year 2

Language Background/Home Language: Student who has a language proficiency code of Non English Proficient (NEP), Limited English Proficient (LEP), Fluent English Proficient (FEP), Primary or Home Language Other Than English (PHLOTE), or Former ELL (FELL) must have a language background other than English (eng). Please see a Microsoft Excel version of the language codes at the following link:

Continuous in District: Student has been continuously enrolled in the district over the course of the academic year leading up to the administration of annual state assessments. This field will be filled with a calculated value based on October Count enrollment in the Responsible District. Please review and check this field carefully especially if you are changing the Responsible District field. Students coded with 0 will not be included in your accountability data.
A student is considered to be continuously enrolled in a district if all of the statements listed below are true. Students failing to meet one or more of these criteria are considered to be non-continuous:

1. The student had an active enrollment record in the district on the October count date.
2. The student had an active enrollment record in the district at the start of the testing window or at any point prior to the end of the testing window.
3. The district code in the student's enrollment record as of the October count date was equal to the district code in the student's enrollment record at the time of the test administration.

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4. Between the student's enrollment on the October count date and the testing date, there has been no single enrollment gap within the district lasting 10 or more consecutive instructional days.
5. Between the student's enrollment on the October count date and the testing date, there have not been multiple non-consecutive enrollment breaks within the district cumulatively equaling 10 or more instructional days.

Continuous in School: Student has been continuously enrolled in the school over the course of the academic year leading up to the administration of annual state assessments. Students who have been continuously enrolled in the school should be coded as 1 . Students who have not been continuously enrolled should be coded as 0 . This field will be filled with a calculated value based on October Count enrollment in the Responsible School. Please review and check this field carefully especially if you are changing the Responsible School field. Students coded with 0 will not be included in your accountability data.

NOTE: The values that you provide for these fields will be compared to the CDE calculated values and will trigger an error if the value you provide does not match the interchange records. If you believe there is an error with the calculated value, contact SBD Support.

Date First Enrolled in US: Date a student first enrolled in any public or non-public US school (not Puerto Rico) in grade kindergarten or higher. Date must be entered in MMDDYYYY format.

- Schools on US military bases count as US schools even if the base is in a different country.
- Home school does not count as a public or non-public school.
- Date First Enrolled in US is based on the earliest entry date in grades kindergarten and higher. The date that a student is enrolled in a pre-school program does not count as the Date First Enrolled in US.
- If you enter a date that is later than the date of first enrollment according to CDE's enrollment records, you will receive an error message. In this case, we recommend that you fill this field with 8 zeros and CDE will provide the earlier date.
- If you do not know the date of first enrollment, you may fill this field with 8 zeros. If information is available, CDE will provide the date of first enrollment.
- If you fill this field with 8 zeros and CDE has no prior enrollment information, you will receive an error message. In this case, use the table below to determine the date to use for date of first enrollment. You may need to work with the District Data Respondent or a school registrar to find the entry type code for a student.

Expelled: Use this field to indicate that a student was expelled at the time of testing.
$0=$ No; 1 = Yes

## NOTES:

- The scores of expelled students will not be included in school level reporting, but will be included for all district level and state level reporting.
- Do not invalidate a student score just because the student was expelled on test day. As long as the student completed the assessment, the score will be included for all district level and state level reporting. For more information contact SBD support.

Invalidation Code: This code will be used to determine the student's invalidation for accountability purposes. If you see multiple codes indicated, then that is what was submitted on the student answer sheet. Please update multiple values with a single valid code. If a student does not meet attemptedness requirements and no invalidation code is applied, the record will trigger a warning. Make sure to review the student information to check if an invalidation should be applied to the record. This can impact school and district participation for accountability as any non-participating record with no invalidation is counted as a non-participant.

Providing an invalidation code invalidates the record for CDE reporting only. As long as there is a valid score, it will not prevent the student from receiving a score report nor will it prevent the student's scores from being included in reports generated by College Board.

Examples:

- A student has never attended school
- Very limited schooling options in a student's former country significantly impeded the student's exposure to formal education (e.g., school was held sporadically; the only school was very far away)
- A student was prohibited from attending school due to a disability, gender, and/or age
b) Interruptions in formal education due to war, civil unrest, migration to the U.S., limited access to schools, etc., resulting in:

Two or more fewer years of formal schooling in prior country/ies compared to U.S. similarly-aged peers
Example:

- A student is placed in 10th grade upon January enrollment in U.S. schools based on age; however, the student has completed only seventh grade or lower. Most of the student's peers would have completed ninth grade before beginning 10th grade. OR
Missed six consecutive school year months or more of formal schooling immediately prior to enrolling in U.S. school Example:
- A student is placed in 8th grade upon January enrollment in U.S. schools based on age. The student missed 4 month of schooling in the US (Sept, Oct, Nov and Dec) and missed at least the last two months of schooling in their former country (April and May). The last time the student was in school was March 2023. Keep in mind, different countries may have school year calendars that are different from the typical US school calendars.

College Board ID: Unique ID assigned by College Board for each student, per assessment/per sitting; may change for a given student if duplicate records are created and/or merged.

Student Participation Indicator: This field is new for the 2022-2023 collection and provides information from College Board around assessment attemptedness. It is intended to aid districts in understanding the status of student records.

## Valid Values:

- $Y=$ Yes: A student testing record was received by College Board and it met attemptedness criteria, which means there was at least 1 gridded response across the Math and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) sections.
- Blank: A student testing record was not returned, or a student testing record was returned that did not contain any multiple-choice responses, therefore it does not meet the criteria for an attempt.
