Special Education End of Year Report Checklist

This document provides an **optional** checklist which data respondents and their directors may use to track their progress through the review and submission of SPED End of Year Reports. This checklist was created in response to a request from the field. If you have any suggestions regarding the checklist, please email Josh Fails at Fails_J@cde.state.co.us.

The Checklist is color-coded to match the colors of the slides from the SPED EOY Report Webinar.

- The first section of the checklist covers the Error Reports that should be:
 - o Reviewed before the Exception request deadline, August 29, 2024
 - o Resolved at the Snapshot level by September 5, 2024
- The second section of the checklist covers the reports that must be **reviewed** by directors during:
 - o The Initial Report Review Week September 6 September 13 and,
 - The Final Report Review September 23 September 27.
- The third section covers the reports that must be signed by directors and submitted by September 27, 2024.
- The final section of the checklist contains tables of common codes that will be encountered in the reports.

This year 8 signature reports are required. The Flag Explanation Report is only required if your Administrative Unit had any significant changes flagged in your Year-to-Year reports. Significant changes are flagged if a category changes by a count of 20 or more AND a percentage of 20% or more. Changes that fit both criteria will be flagged with an "A" in the Year-to-Year reports.

This Checklist contains some quick reference lists for codes. See the code tables for Delays (updated), Disabilities and Exits at the end of the list.

The data captured in the SPED EOY Snapshot are used for Federal and Indicator reporting, to monitor state performance, and in policy development decisions.
