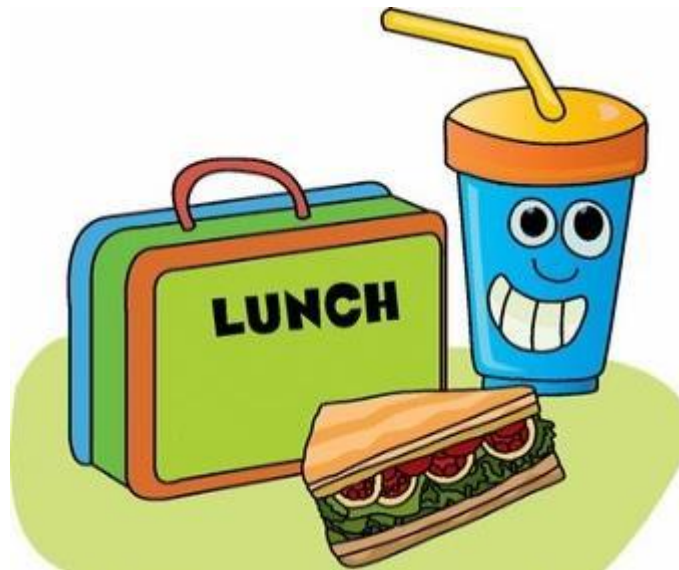

School Health Services (Nursing)

Immunization Exemptions

- Effective July 2016, non-medical exemptions required to be signed annually
- Parents must sign the official exemption form from CDPHE
- Official exemption form recently updated (September 2016)

School Health Services (Nursing)

Immunization Data

- Beginning in SY2016-2017, Colorado schools and licensed child cares must report aggregate immunization data to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) by December 1 of each year, per [Colorado Board of Health rule 6 CCR 1009-2.](#)
- The [school](#) and [child care](#) reporting surveys are now open for official reporting and will remain open through December 1, 2016.

School Health Services (Nursing)

Medical Marijuana in Schools HB16-1371

- Districts should have a policy in place
- Parents or caregiver may come on school grounds to administer medical marijuana
- It must be in non-smokable form
- Student must have a red card from state health department - this is not a prescription
- Staff is not required to administer

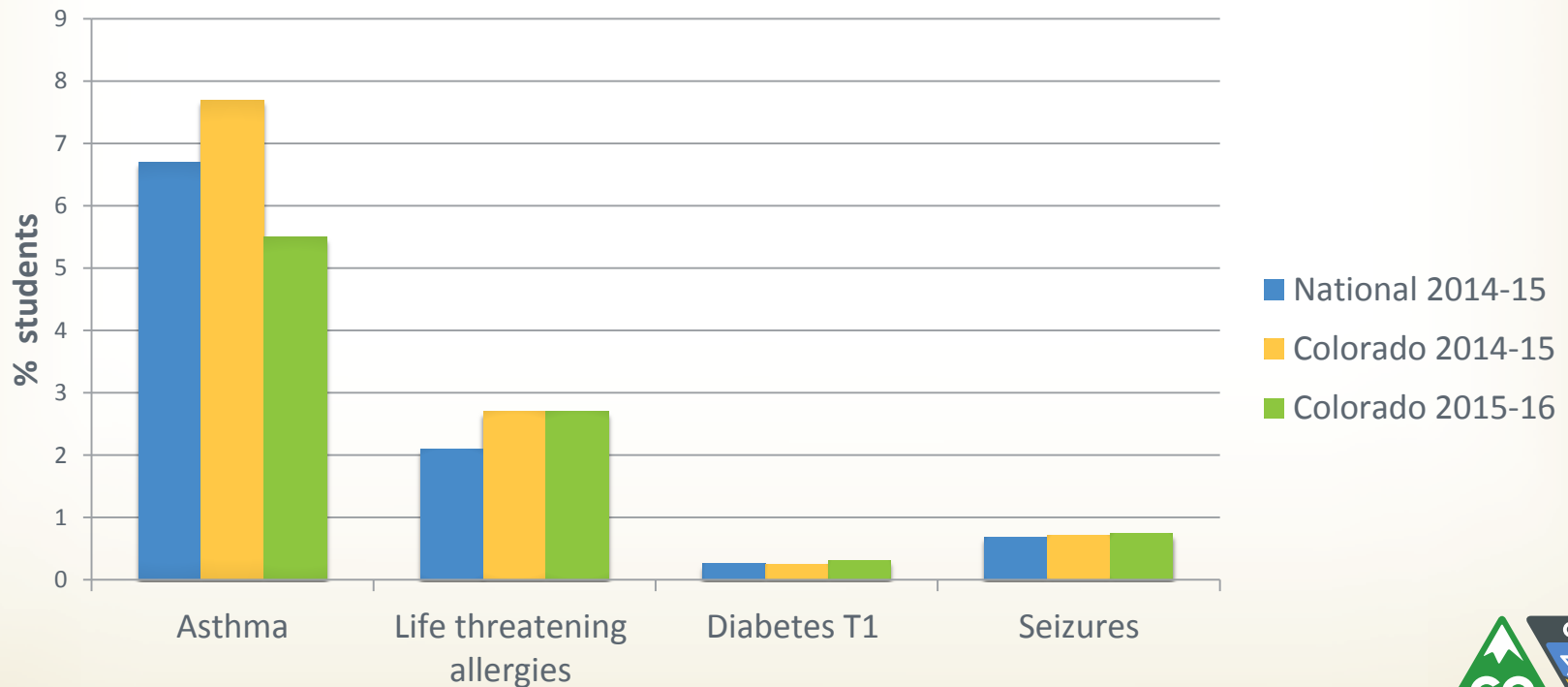
