- ✓ Must be sixteen (16) years of age
- ✓ Register for a HiSET account online at <u>HiSET.org</u> <u>before</u> submitting application; HiSET will notify you of your application status in your HiSET student account
- ✓ Fill out application and provide supporting letter for the condition for which you are applying (see below)
- ✓ You can visit cde.state.co.us/postsecondary/hse agewaiver for more details on the age waiver process

After registering online with HiSET, go to hiset.org/age-waiver-process and select "Request an Age Waiver". Fill out the form that appears. At the bottom of the form, click "Add file" to attach this age waiver AND the supporting letter. Then click "Submit". Your application will be reviewed, and you will be notified of approval or denial in your student account.
