## Resolution Recognizing the Contribution Randy DeHoff Has Made to the Education of Children in Colorado

- WHEREAS: Randy DeHoff has served on the State Board of Education since January of 1999; and,
- WHEREAS: Since that time, he has served once as chairman and twice as vice chairman; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout the years, he has made an invaluable contribution to education in Colorado, focusing on the instruction of math and science and serving on many boards and committees as an expert in these areas; and,
- WHEREAS: He has equally emphasized the importance of instruction in the arts, particularly the importance of music in curriculum; and,
- WHEREAS: He has been a strong advocate for 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning, moving away from the concept of “seat time” and towards the utilization of online instruction and technology;
- WHEREAS: He has been a strong advocate of charter schools, having served as executive director of the Charter School Institute, and is a well-respected expert in this area of educational choice; and,
- WHEREAS: He has served on many committees and boards on both a state and national level, including serving on the Board of Directors of the National Association of State Boards of Education; and,
- WHEREAS: In 2010, the National Association of State Boards of Education awarded Mr. DeHoff the Distinguished Service Award; and,
- WHEREAS: Mr. DeHoff, along with the board as a whole, selected Dwight D. Jones as commissioner of education in 2007; and,
- WHEREAS: He, along with the board as a whole, supported the Department’s long-term and on-going efforts to implement Colorado’s education reform agenda, including, among others, the development of the state longitudinal data system known as “SchoolView” and the adoption of the Colorado Revised Model Content Standards in December 2009; now, therefore,


