## **Colorado Fast Facts**

- ♣ Over \$157.09 million in federal funds and over \$4.2 million in state funds are received to support Colorado's Child Nutrition programs
- Colorado schools serve 63.9 million lunches and 22.7 million breakfasts
- Over 1.3 million summer meals were served last summer in Colorado; this is 333,406 more served meals than summer of 2010
- \$14.06 million in USDA donated foods are distributed to Colorado Child Nutrition sponsors
- Average daily participation in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) is 376,060 based on 170 days\*
- Average daily participation in the School Breakfast Program (SBP) is 133,638 based on 170 days\*
- Total number of current schools participating in the:
  - NSLP = 1674
  - SBP = 1371
- Total number of children approved statewide:
  - Total K-12 Count = 830,129
    - Free = 288,754 (34.8%)
    - Reduced Price = 60,442 (7.3%)
    - Paid = 480,933 (57.9%)
- Colorado has been awarded \$2.92 million for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP) for SY 2012-2013
