

American Rescue Plan - Homeless Children and Youth II Funding (ARP-HCY II)

Performance Period 7/1/21 - 9/30/23

Budget: 1-year budgets are submitted annually each year of the performance period. 100% carry over will be approved.

Tydings: Funds appropriated under the ARP-HCY program will be available until September 30, 2024. *Under section 421(b) of the General Education Provisions Act, funds not obligated and expended prior to the beginning of the fiscal year following the fiscal year for which funds were appropriated remain available for obligation and expenditure for an additional year.*

Financial Reporting Requirements

- Interim Financial Report due 4/30/22 for period 7/1/21 - 3/31/22
- Annual Financial Report due 10/31/22 for period 7/1/21 - 9/30/22
- Year 2 budgets submitted 7/31/22 for any remaining allocation
- Grant Award Letter issued for remaining allocation 11/22
- Interim Financial Report due 4/30/23 for period 7/1/22 - 3/31/23
- Annual Financial Report due 10/31/23 for period 7/1/22 -9/30/23

Q&A

Should we submit a one-year budget for the full amount awarded through the formula?

Yes, please create a one year budget for the full amount of the formula award. You will have the opportunity to make budget revisions in the creation of your carry over budget for year 2. 100% carry over will be approved.

Will there be a second disbursement of funds in year 2?

No, the year 2 budget will only reflect the remaining allocation from year one.

Can I request reimbursement for funding back to July 1, 2021 even though I didn't receive my Grant Award Letter until November or December 2021?

Yes, the performance period for this award began July 1, 2021. You may request reimbursement for expenses related to programming for Homeless Children and Youth beginning July 1, 2021.

What if I don't spend the full allocation by 9/30/23?

As with all funding through ESSER III, Local Education Agencies will be able to spend down their remaining allocation through 9/30/24 based on the year 2 budget submission.
