## November is Homeless Youth Awareness Month

November 1st marked the start of Homeless Youth Awareness Month bringing attention to the important issue of youth homelessness across the state and the nation. In Colorado alone, over 16,000 students lived in shelters, stayed with family or friends, or slept without a roof over their heads during the 2021-22 school year. ## Colorado Academic Accelerator Grant Program Request for Stakeholder Engagement

The Colorado Department of Education (CDE) seeks input from a variety of stakeholders across Colorado to help develop the new Colorado Academic Accelerator Program grant. The CO-AAP grant is authorized by the "Math In Pre-kindergarten Through Twelfth Grade" law (C.R.S. 22-2-146.6), which was passed in 2023 to support student learning in STEM in community learning centers during out-of-school time programs.

The CO-AAP grant competition is expected to launch by December 15, 2023. Applications will be due February 15, 2024. CDE will award approximately \$24 million in state funds over the three-year grant period. For more information, visit the <u>CDE CO-AAP webpage</u>.

#### **Connecting with School Nurses**

School Nurses are important partners in the outreach, identification and connection to services and supports for McKinney-Vento eligible students. As you know, McKinney-Vento eligible students have the **right to immediate enrollment even with missing enrollment documents such as immunization records.** McKinney-Vento Liaisons are encouraged to work with their school nurses to help secure the necessary immunizations for students; however, a lack of immunization records cannot get in the way of the McKinney-Vento eligible student from accessing and participating fully in school and school activities. **Please consider reaching out to your school nurse to share what you know about McKinney-Vento and discuss how they can help in supporting McKinney-Vento eligible students.**
