



Read the sentence to your child, pointing to each word. Then, ask your child to read the sentence to you. Point to each word as your child reads the sentence.

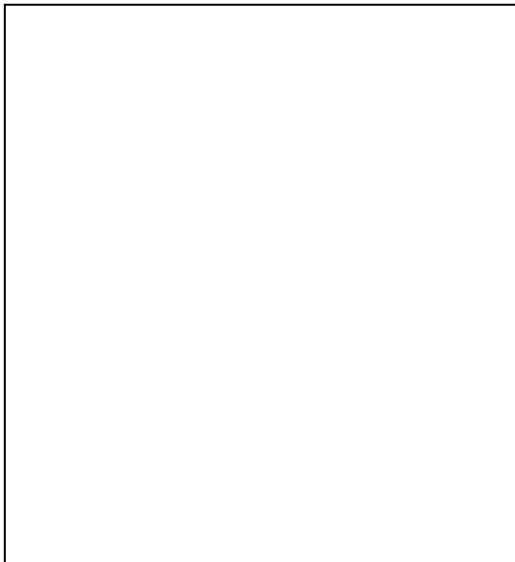
LET'S FIND OUT
