LET'S DO THIS

1. Ask your child: Let's talk about weather words.

What are 4 weather words that start with different letters?

Help your child think about some weather words that start with different letters.

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z

2. Ask your child: Act out the 4 weather words and I will try to guess the weather.
3. Ask your child: Tell me your 4 weather words.
I will print each word on this chart.



4. Ask your child: As I read each word, tell me the **sound** of the **first letter**.
Point and read each word.

Ask your child: **Underline the 1st letter of each word.**

5. With your child: Now, let's put these words in **alphabetical order** on this chart.

Point to each word and ask your child to read it to you in a silly voice to suggest the weather.

LET'S FIND OUT

Ask your child: Let's write your first name and the first names of 4 other family or friends on Chart 1. Choose names that start with different letters.

With your child: Read the 5 names to your child.

Ask your child: Underline the 1st letter in each name.

With your child: Put the names in alphabetical order on Chart 2.

Ask your child: Where does your name fit in the order?
